ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLICANT:

Applicants must fulfill the educational qualification, experience and age limit and other criteria for the post, as on the last date of receipt of the applications, failing which the application shall summarily be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Candidates are, therefore, advised to satisfy themselves before applying for the post that they possess the requisite essential qualification and experience. The prescribed essential qualifications are the bare minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for the interview/selection.

AGE RELAXATION FOR GOVERNMENT SERVANTS:

The upper age limit is relaxable for Government servants and orthopedically handicapped (OH) upto 10 years.

The age relaxation will be admissible to such of the Government servants who are working in posts which are in the same line or allied cadres and where a relationship could be established that the service already rendered in a particular post will be useful for the efficient discharge of the duties of the post(s) recruitment to which has been advertised. The above concession will be admissible only where an employee has rendered not less than three years continuous service under Government.

SCHEME OF SELECTION

Selection of the aforesaid post will be on the basis of written and practical test which will be conducted by a duly constituted Selection Committee.
